COORDINATING GROWTH

Our county is now the 4th fastest-growing community in the state. To help keep pace with this growth, JCDA is collaborating with RK&K civil engineering to identify property for a new commerce park, and to consider the potential redevelopment of existing lots in the Burr Industrial Park.

GRANT ACTIVITY

Our successful grant applications included a *USDA Rural Business Development Grant*, awarded for the creation of a Jefferson County "Agriculture at Home" marketing campaign.

SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE

Fostered on-site small business counseling in collaboration with the WV SBDC.



- Created informational/training sessions for the small business community via the Jefferson Innovators series and the Eastern Panhandle Entrepreneurs Forum.
- Developed Jump Start Jefferson, an initiative to provide guidance and support for local entrepreneurs.



- Introduced small business spotlight series and Agriculture updates blog on JCDA.NET.
- Conducted 36 business retention visits with existing local enterprises.
- Responded to 10 incoming inquiries from prospective businesses—
 3 of which resulted in visits to the county by those prospects.
- Coordinated the sale of 7 lots in Burr Industrial Park.

- Launched the new JCDA.net website, an information-rich resource with business profiles and testimonials, extensive workforce data, maps, available site information, as well as comparisons of Jefferson County to other comparable markets.
