Regional average earnings per job are **\$3.2K below** the national average earnings of \$64.7K per job.

As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 8.2%** since 2013, growing by 96,343. Population is expected to **increase by 6.1%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 77,776.

From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 7.9%** in 14 Counties from 534,816 to **576,965**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 7.4% by 0.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 67.3% to 66.1% between 2013 and 2018**.

Concerning educational attainment, **23.1% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.5% above the national average), and **6.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.2% below the national average).

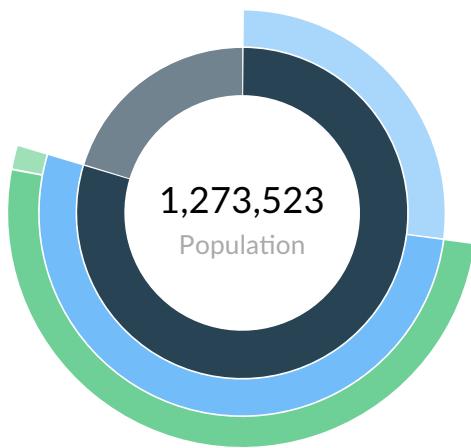
The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Federal Government, Civilian.

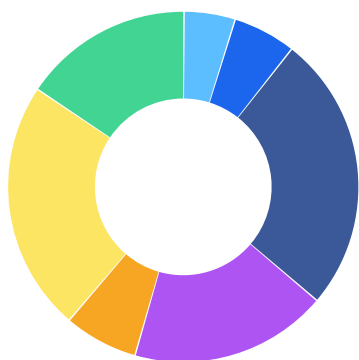
2018 Labor Force Breakdown

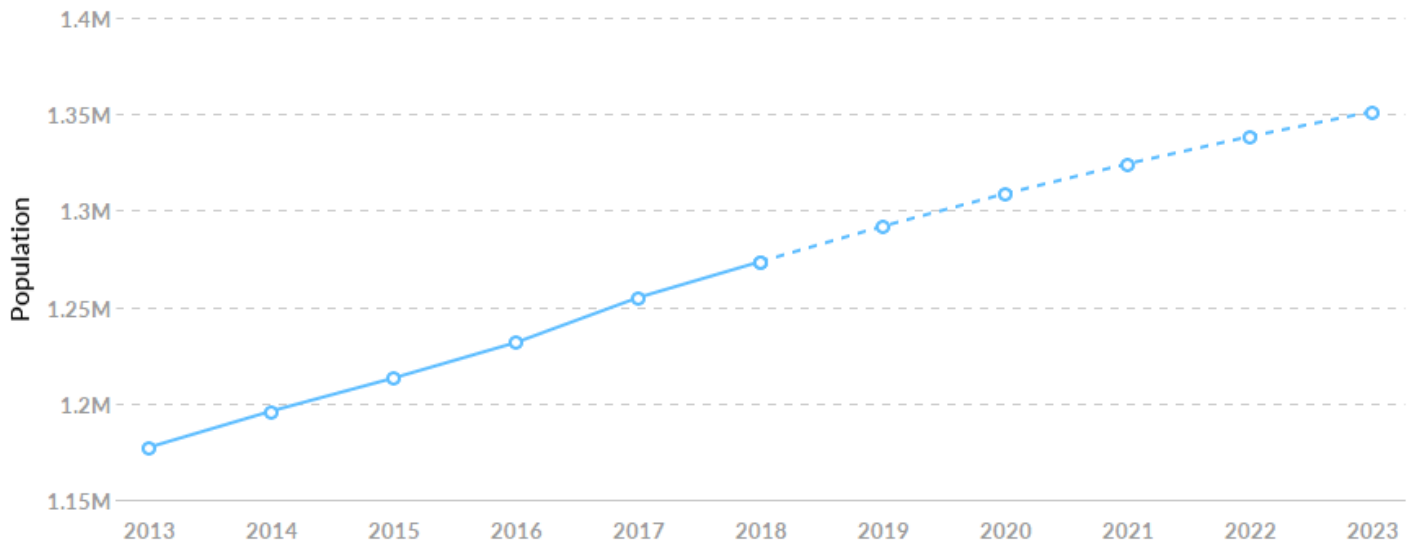

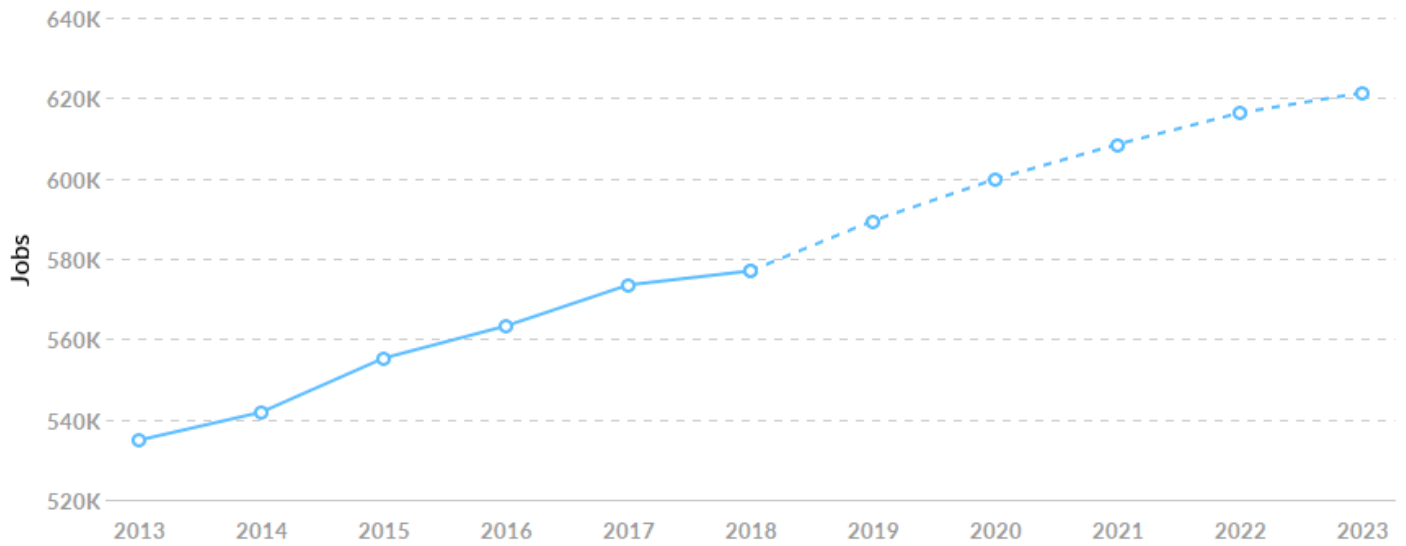

Job Trends

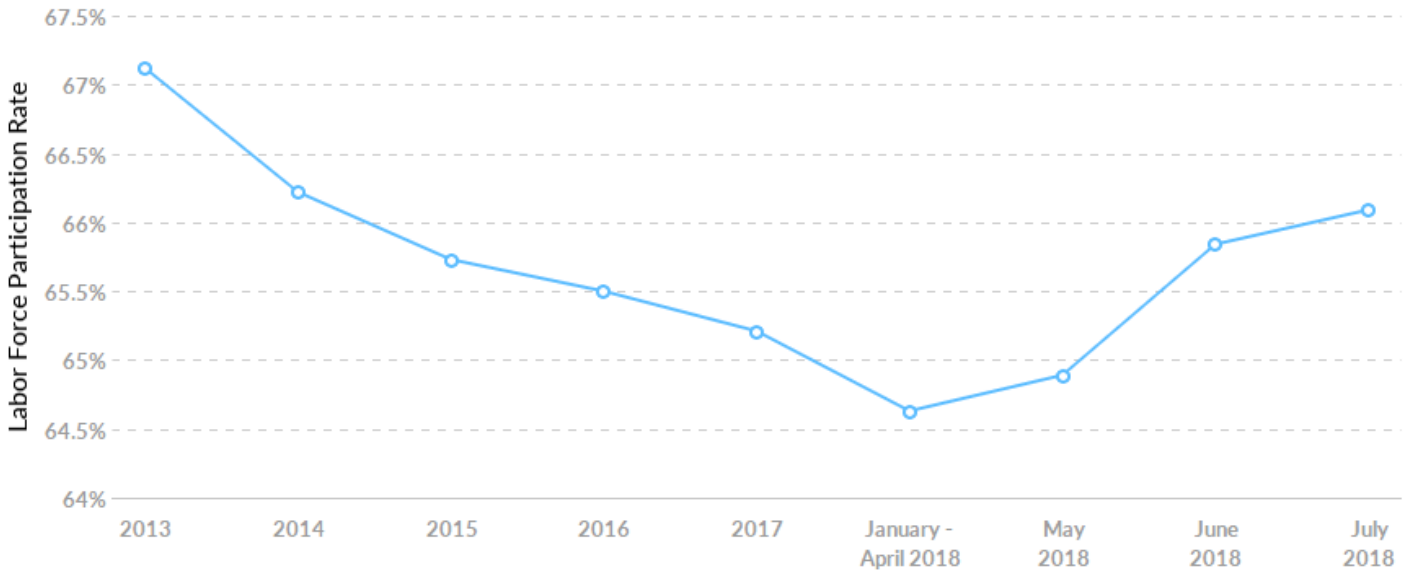

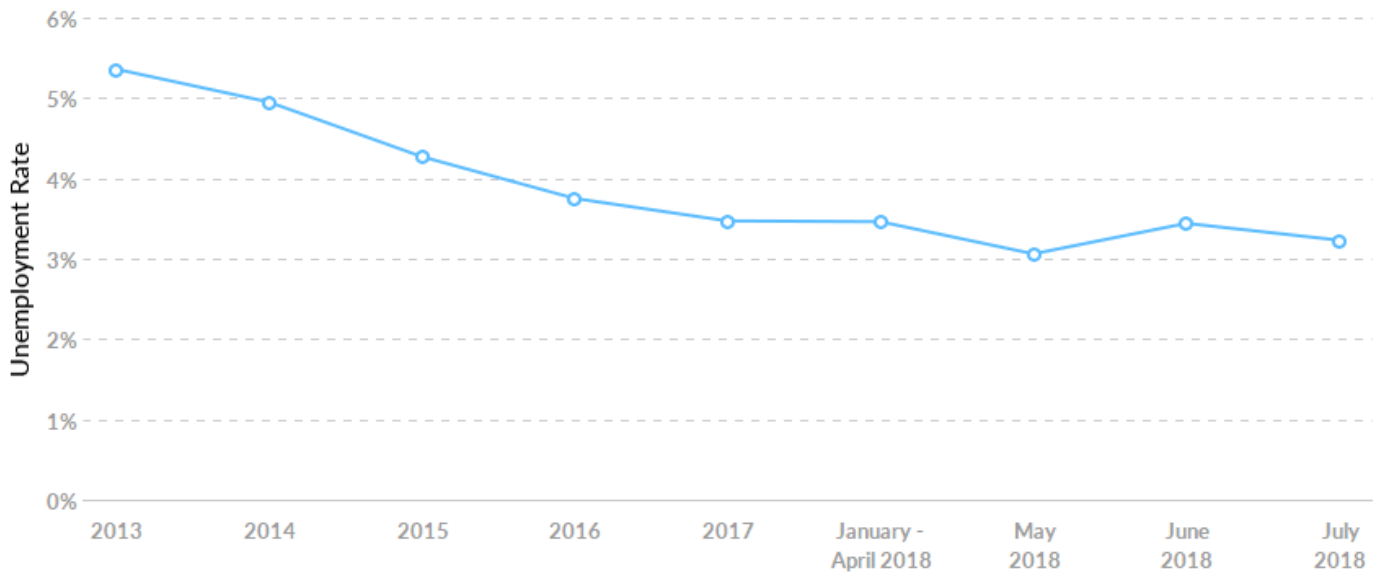

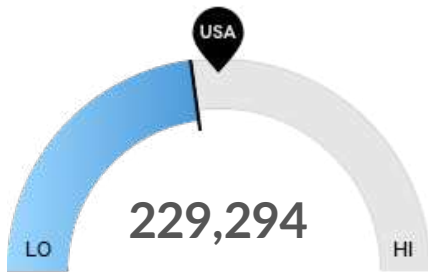
Unemployment Rate Trends

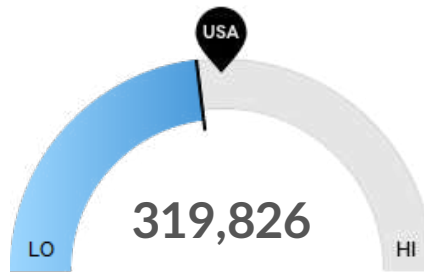

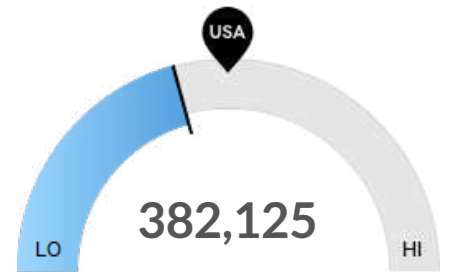
Millennials

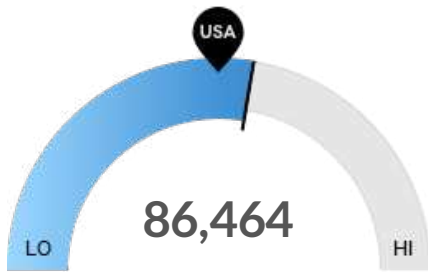

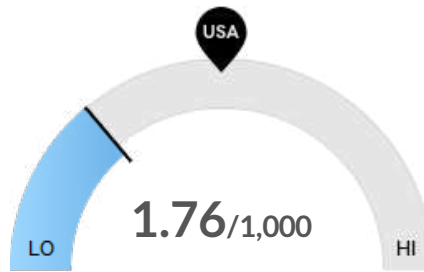

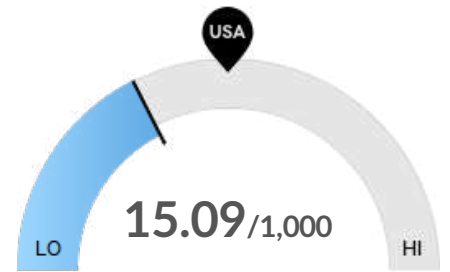

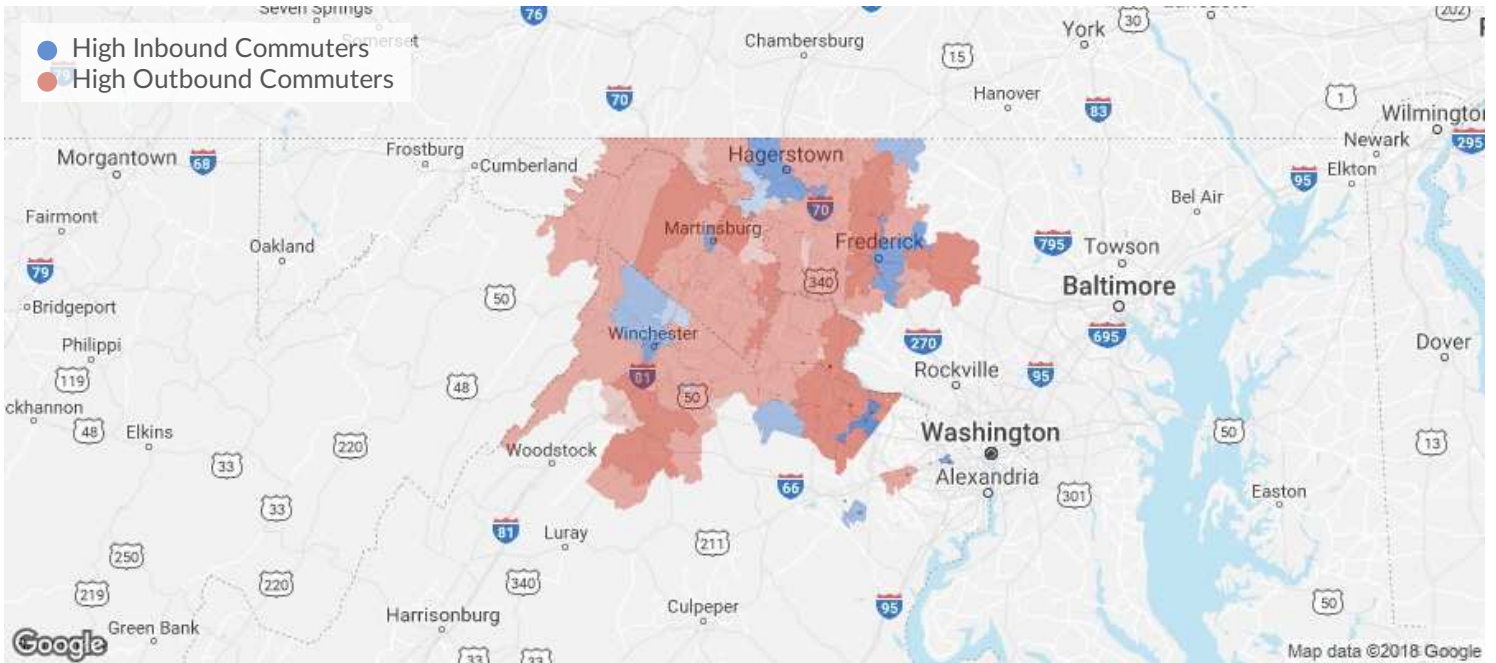

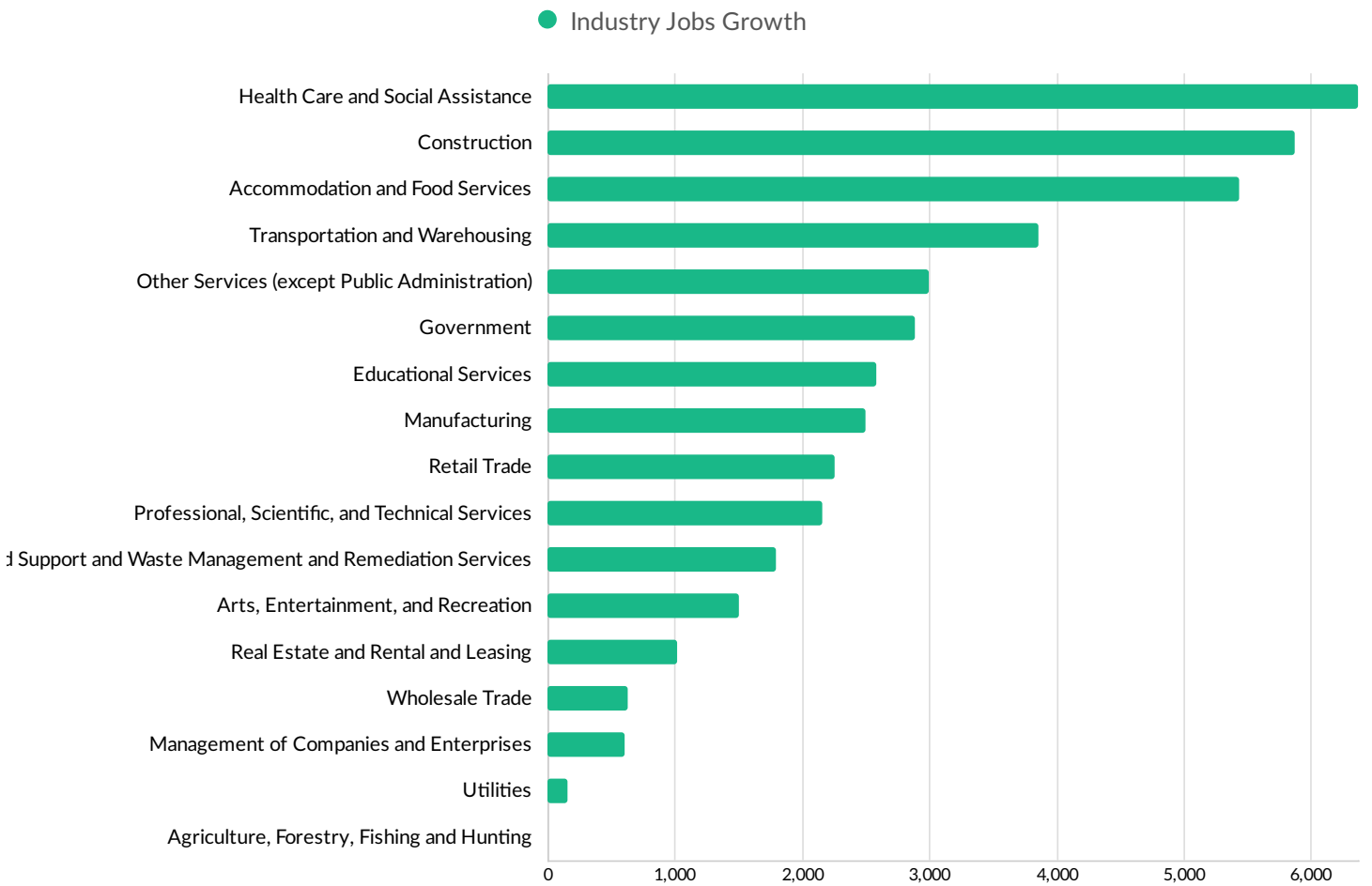

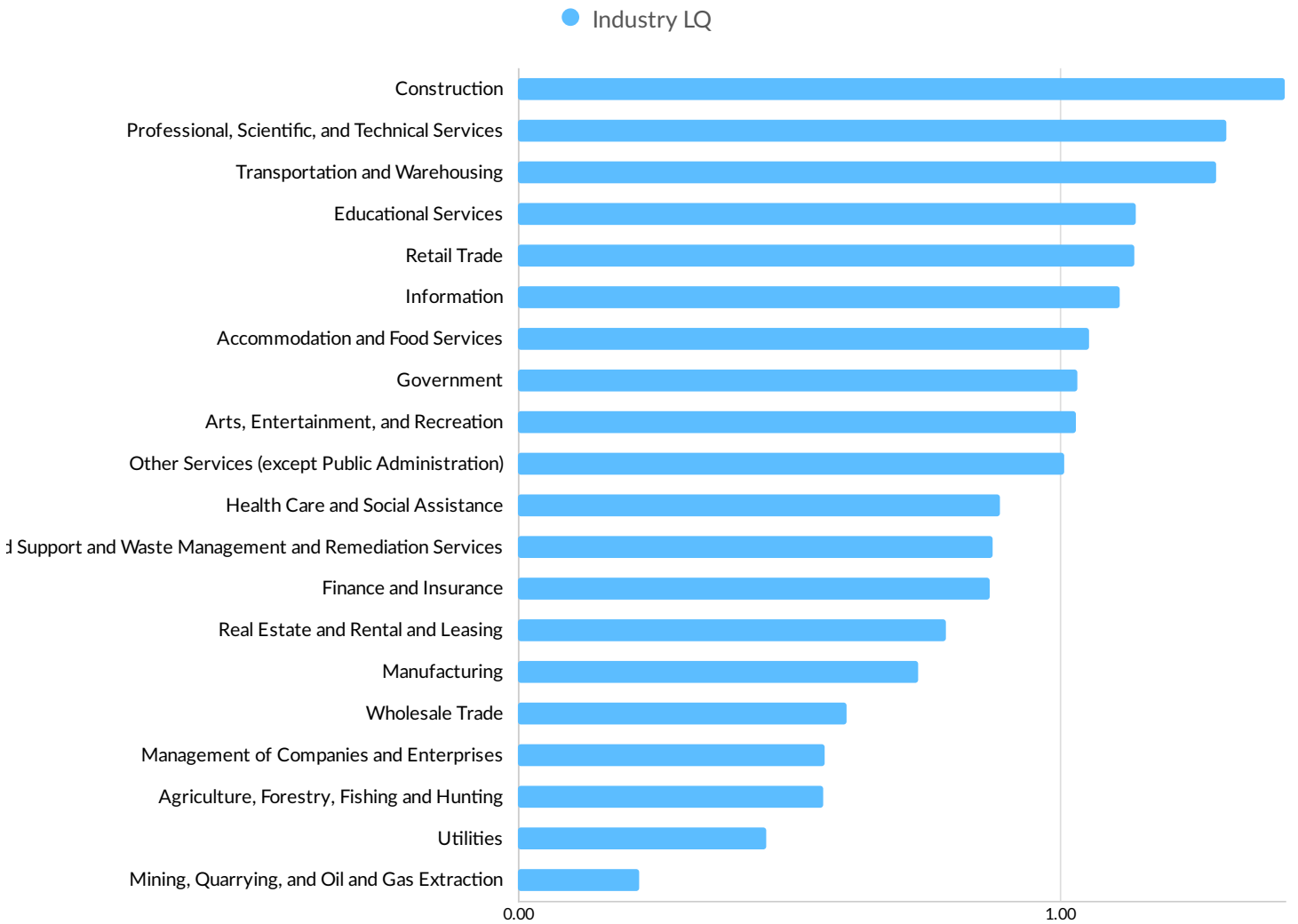

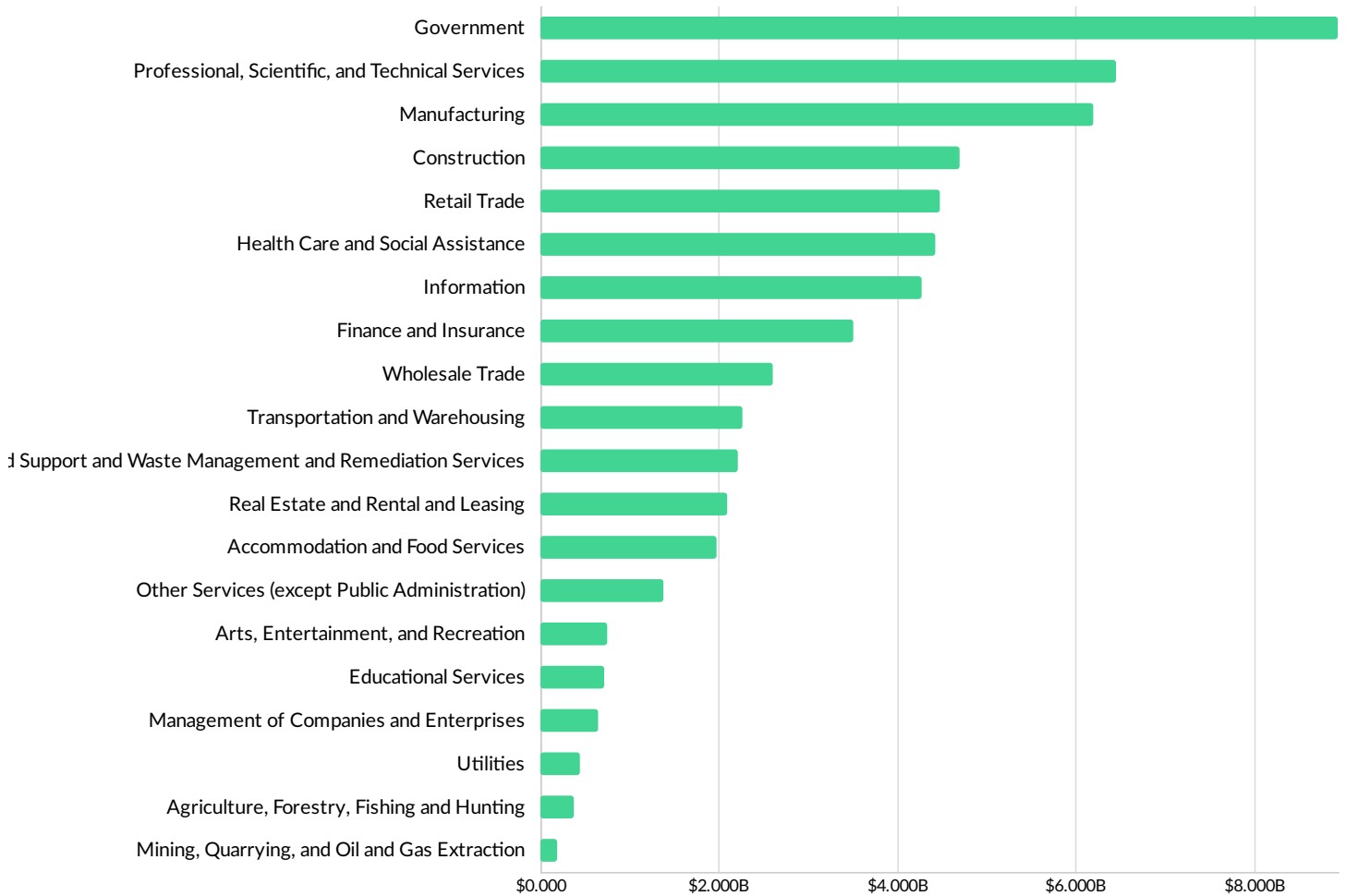
Top Industry LQ

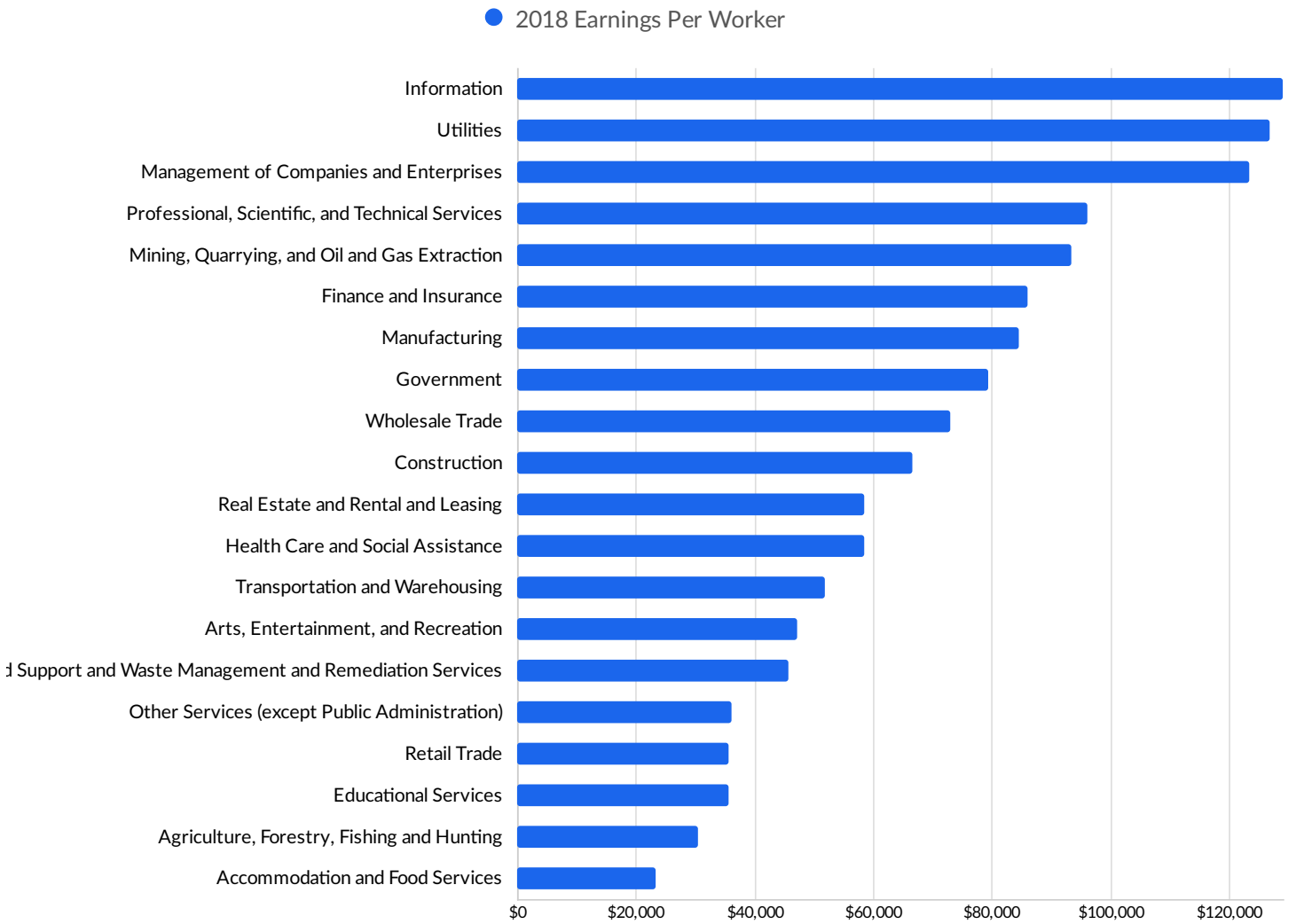
Top Industry GRP

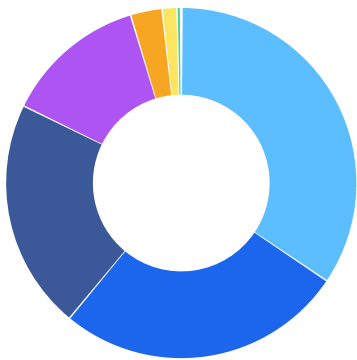

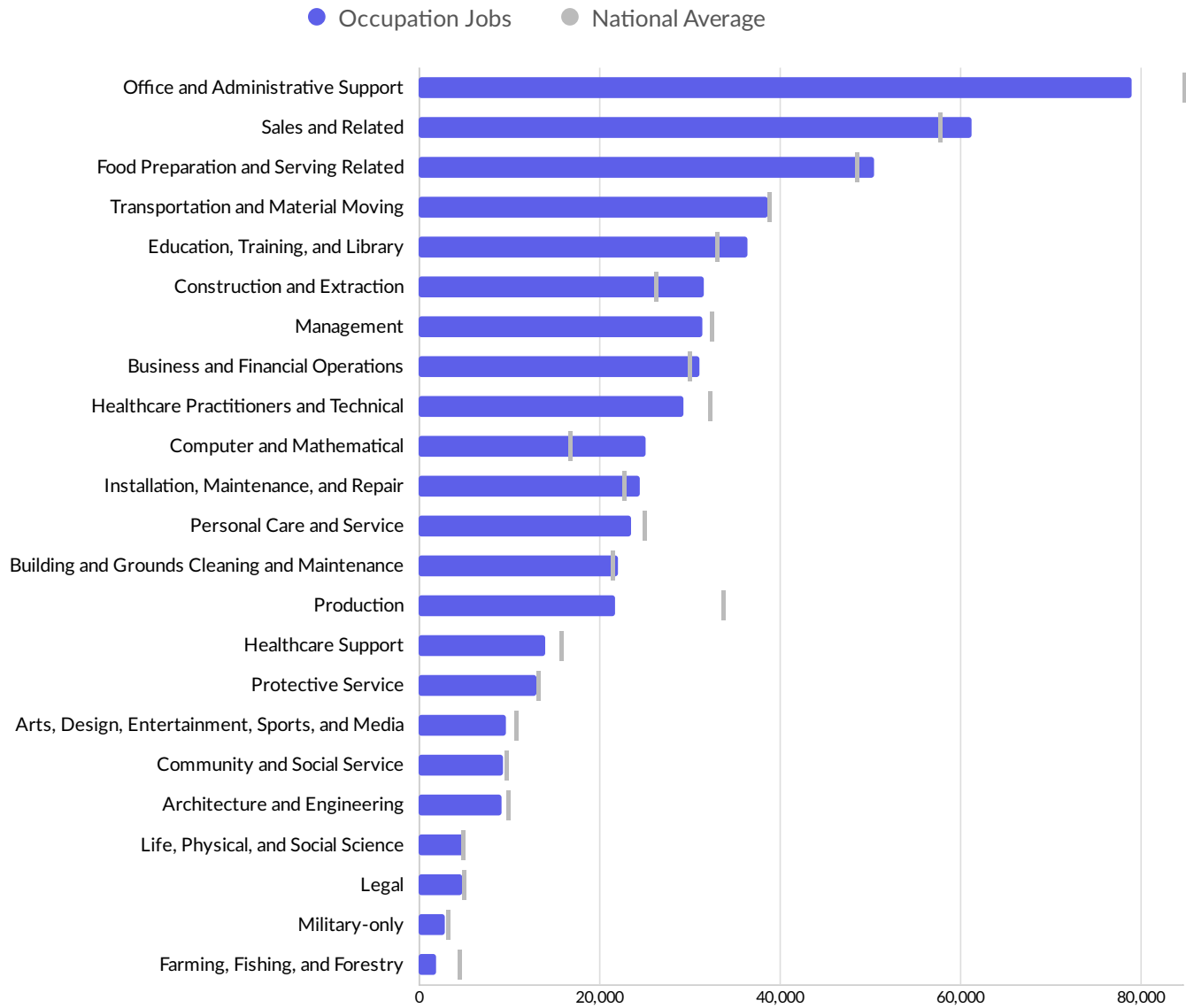

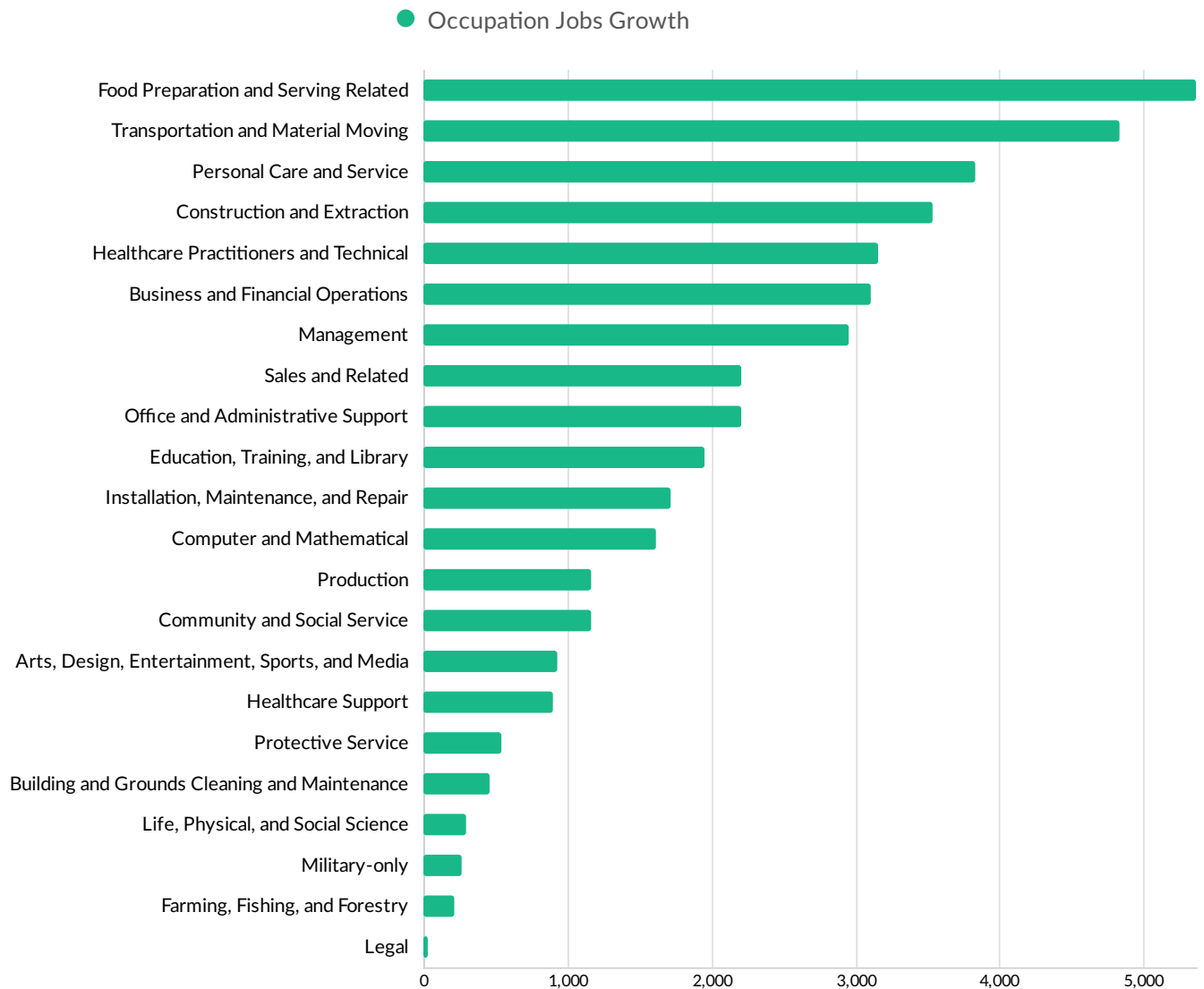

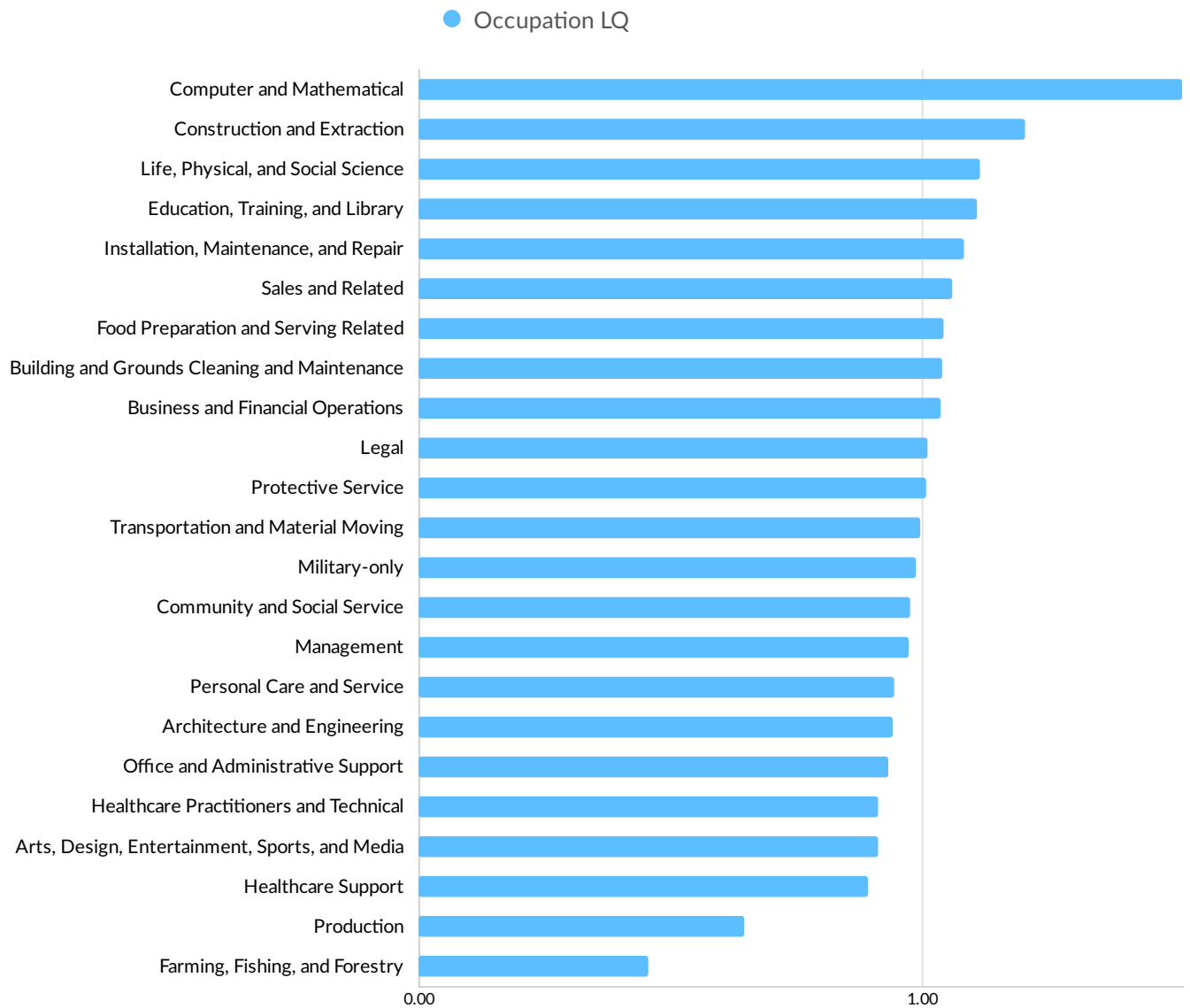

Top Growing Occupations



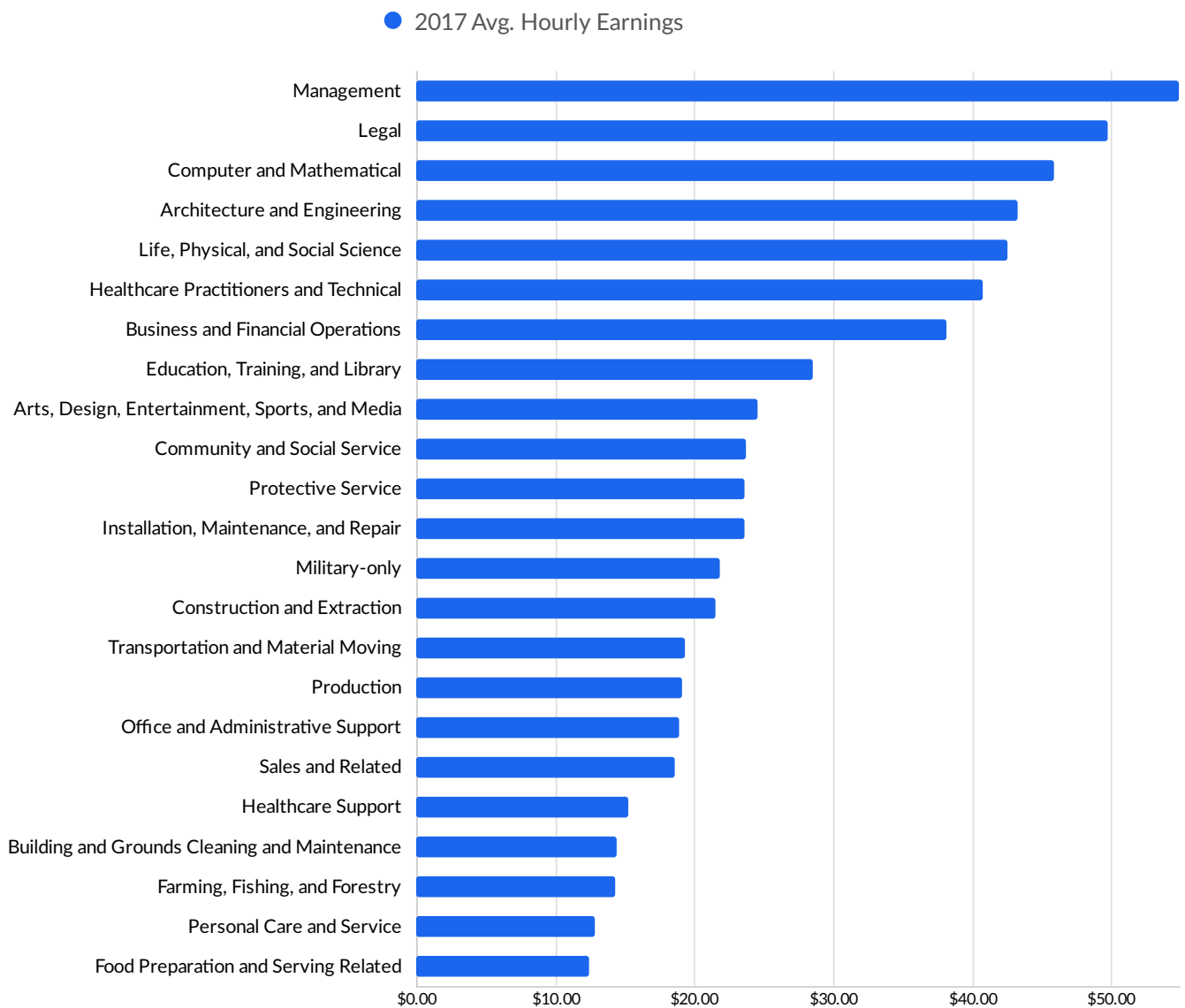

Top Occupation LQ



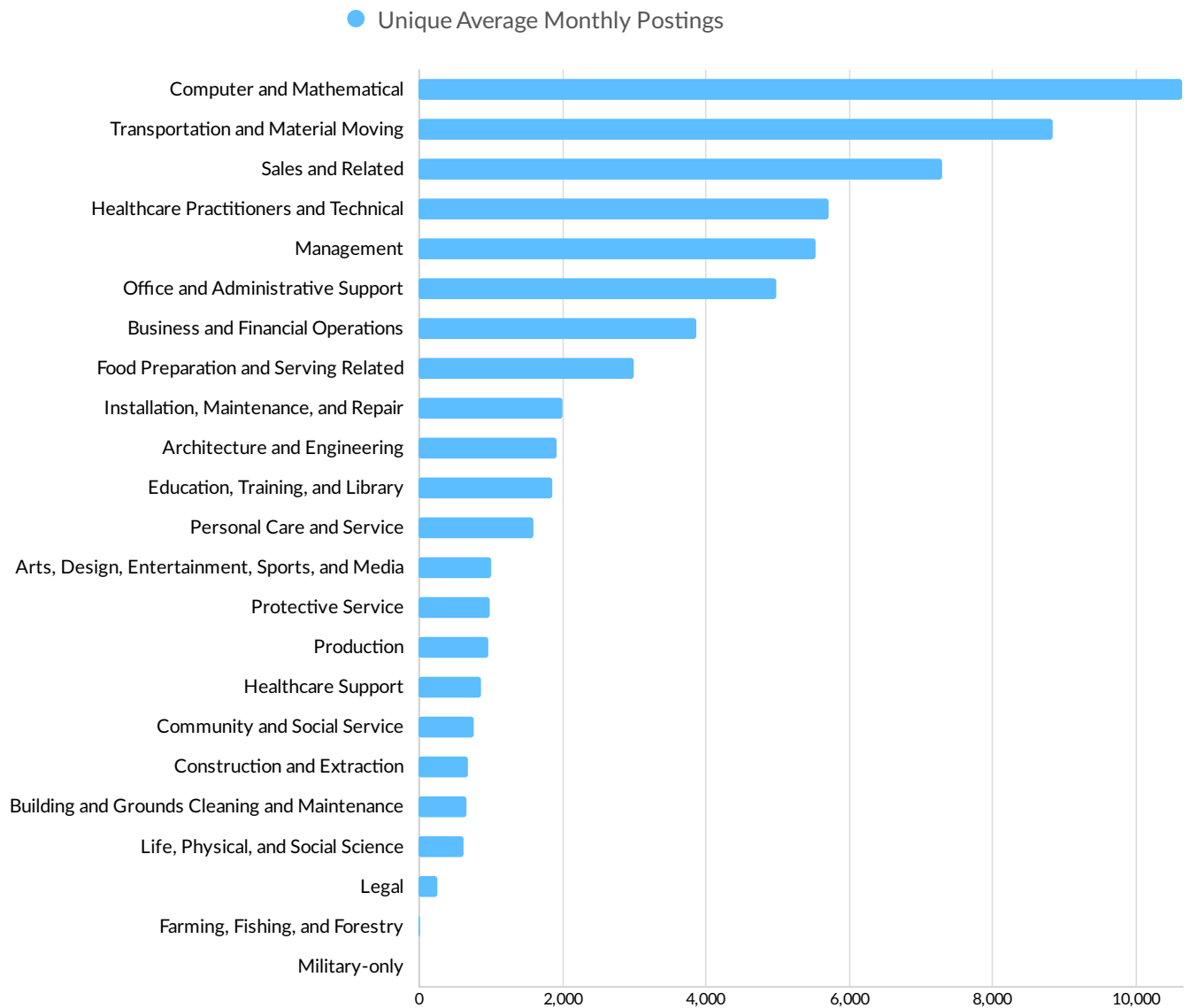
